1. A concert was held in the evening of 5th October 2018, at St Mary's Church, Green Road, Alverstone, for which more than 300 people had bought tickets. In addition to the audience, there were around 75 performers, making a total of 383 people travelling to the concert.
2. Although this was not being held in the Parish Centre, the Regeneration Project team thought it would provide a representative picture of modes of travel that could be expected at a large event in the proposed new development, where the maximum number of people licenced for the building would be around 240.
